

Asterix And The Class Act Album 32 Fourteen All New Asterix Stories

Por volta de 390 a.C., o chefe gaulês Brennus atravessou os Alpes, derrotou os romanos na Batalha de Allia e demitiu Roma por vários meses. A invasão gaulesa deixou Roma enfraquecida e incentivou várias tribos italianas a se rebelar. Uma a uma, ao longo dos 50 anos seguintes, essas tribos foram derrotadas e trazidas de volta ao domínio romano. Enquanto isso, os gauleses continuariam a assediar a região até 345 a.C., quando entraram em um tratado formal com Roma. Romanos e gauleses, porém, manteriam um relacionamento adversário pelos próximos séculos e os gauleses continuariam sendo uma ameaça na Itália. Por volta de 125 a.C., o sul da França é conquistado pelos romanos que chamavam essa região de Província Romana, que evoluiu para o nome Provence em francês. O saco de Roma de Brennus ainda era lembrado pelos romanos, quando Júlio César conquistou o restante da Gália. Inicialmente, César encontrou pouca resistência gaulesa: as cerca de 60 tribos que compunham a Gália não conseguiram unir e derrotar o exército romano, algo que César explorou colocando uma tribo contra outra. Em 58 a.C., César derrotou a tribo germânica dos Suebi, liderada por Ariovistus. No ano seguinte, ele conquistou os gauleses belgas depois de afirmar que eles estavam conspirando contra Roma. A série de vitórias continuou em um triunfo naval contra os Veneti em 56 a.C. Em 53 a.C., surgiu pela primeira vez um movimento unido de resistência gálica sob Vercingetorix. César sitiou a cidade fortificada de Avaricum (Bourges) e rompeu as defesas após 25 dias, com apenas 800 dos 40.000 habitantes conseguindo escapar. Ele então sitiou Gergovia, a cidade natal de Vercingetorix, e sofreu uma das piores derrotas em sua carreira quando teve que se retirar para reprimir uma revolta em outra parte da Gália. Depois de voltar, César cercou Vercingetorix em Alesia em 52 a.C. As pessoas da cidade foram mortas pela submissão e as únicas obras de terra defensivas de César, projetando-se para a cidade e para longe dela, a fim de parar uma enorme força de ajuda gaulesa, eventualmente forçou Vercingetorix a se render. As guerras gálicas terminaram.

Whereas in English-speaking countries comics are for children or adults 'who should know better', in France and Belgium the form is recognized as the 'Ninth Art' and follows in the path of poetry, architecture, painting and cinema. The bande dessinée [comic strip] has its own national institutions, regularly obtains front-page coverage and has received the approval of statesmen from De Gaulle onwards. On the way to providing a comprehensive introduction to the most francophone cultural phenomena, this book considers national specificity as relevant to an anglophone reader, whilst exploring related issues such as text/image expression, historical precedents and sociological implication. To do so it presents and analyses priceless manuscripts, a Franco- American rodent, Nazi propaganda, a museum-piece urinal, intellectual gay porn and a prehistoric warrior who's really Zinedine Zidane.

Comics are a pervasive art form and an intrinsic part of the cultural fabric of most countries. And yet, relatively little has been written on the translation of comics. Comics in Translation attempts to address this gap in the literature and to provide the first and most comprehensive account of various aspects of a diverse range of social practices subsumed under the term 'comics'. Focusing on the role played by translation in shaping graphic narratives that appear in various formats, different contributors examine various aspects of this popular phenomenon. The volume features illustrations from the works discussed and an extensive annotated bibliography.
